The Springfield Fortnightly musical Club has set aside \$1,000 to further the musical education of any student (s) who meets the following criteria:

**ELIGIBILITY:**

The applicant must be a high school senior who resides in Clark County and must attend a public or private school in Clark County or Fairborn High School in Greene County. Home Schooled applicants are also eligible to apply as long as they meet the state standards to graduate this May or June.

He/She must plan to major in music in a college or university program after graduation. The applicant must give a live performance of TWO compositions of contrasting styles for judges selected by the Springfield Music Club. Total length of performance should not exceed 10 minutes. Submission of a tape for the audition is not permissible. Teachers or relatives of the contestants will not be allowed to judge.

Auditions will be held on Saturday morning, May 2, 2020 at Northridge United Methodist Church, 4610 Derr Road, Springfield at 9:30 a.m. (2 blocks right off Moorefield Road.) Applicants will perform before a panel of judges as well as some of those students auditioning. The order of performance will be random, unless a specific time is requested.

Scholarships will be awarded according to the decision of the judges. The judges have the right to declare no winner. The judges' decisions are final. The winner will be notified by telephone within 3 days of the audition date.

All instrumentalists and vocalists must memorize at least ONE of the two compositions. Each participant is to provide his/her own accompanist if one is needed. The participant is to give an ORIGINAL COPY of each of his/her compositions to the judges before performing that morning. The applicant will be judged on TALENT with the following areas graded: 1. MUSICIANSHIP 2. INTERPRETATION 3. TECHNIQUE 4. STAGE PRESENCE.

The winner (s) will be requested to perform for the members at the annual May meeting of the club on Tuesday, May 17 at 7:00 at Northridge United Methodist Church, 4610 Derr Road and receive his/her scholarship money at that time.

The applicant must complete the following and mail or personally deliver to: Mary Anne Blazer, 771 North Enon Road, Yellow Springs, Ohio 45387 (Phone: 937-767-1892) by April 20. The information sent MUST include: 1) the application and your college and future plans plus recommendation from your high school music teacher; 2) On a separate paper please list all your musical activities at school, church, or community and other activities involved in and awards received.

Extra copies of this and the application can be xeroxed to post in the counselor's office, music rooms or give to eligible seniors going on in music.
