Re: Rotary Scholarships - Martin Family Scholarship; Charles L. Fox Scholarship

This year, the Springfield Rotary Club will award three scholarships to outstanding high school seniors in Clark County.

- Martin Scholarship \$2500 per year for 4 years; requires maintaining a 2.75 GPA
- Fox Scholarship \$2000 per year for 4 years; requires maintaining a 3.0 GPA

Students only need to submit one application to be considered for all scholarships. Enclosed you will find two sets of applications (you may make additional copies as needed). The cover page of each application explains the scholarship criteria and process. The Rotary Club would appreciate your distributing these applications to seniors who have an interest in these scholarships and who meet the following criteria:

- Clark County resident
- Rank in the top ten, or ten percent, of graduating class (whichever is the greater number of students)
- Provide evidence of leadership and community service

Once we receive the applications, we will schedule interviews. Depending on the total number of applicants, it may be necessary to conduct preliminary screening to determine candidates for interviews. Please remind students to answer all questions on the application; sometimes students do not show family income, and this makes them ineligible. Please note that we will not consider any applicant who does not meet the above criteria or submits an incomplete application. After the interviews, we will award the scholarships to the students who are rated highest by the Rotary Scholarship Committee.

Please return, or have the students mail the applications to Rotary Club Scholarship, 700 Westchester Park Drive, Springfield, Ohio 45504. Applications must be **postmarked by March 20, 2020**. Springfield Rotary Club Scholarships Information for Martin Family, Charles L. Fox Scholarships

Basic requirements to qualify for a Rotary Scholarship:

High school applicants must:

- 1. Reside in Clark County.
- 2. Attend a Clark County High School
- 3. Be graduating from a Clark County high school in the year of application with the following GPA: Martin Scholarship 3.5 or better; Fox Scholarship 3.0 or better
- Have given community service that is additional to any school requirement.
- Show evidence of leadership involvement while in high school.
- Submit a recommendation from a teacher.
- Submit a recommendation from a community member (someone outside the school system).

Note: Children of Springfield Rotary Club members are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Selection will be based on:

- 1. Scholarship
- 2. Assessment of need based on Adjusted Gross Income and other information provided by Applicant
- 3. School and community service
- 4. Recommendations

Scholarship amount:

The amount of the scholarship is based upon the earnings of the scholarship fund; it is estimated to be \$2500 (Martin) and \$2000 (Fox). The scholarship is renewable for three more years provided the recipient remains a full-time student and submits a transcript for each subsequent funding request showing a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.75 (Martin) or 3.0 (Fox). Scholarships are applied toward tuition, books, and fees. The amount of the scholarship will be forwarded directly to the registrar of the College. The amount of the scholarship in subsequent years may be different from the award in the first year, depending upon earnings in the scholarship fund.

Selection criteria:

The selection will be made by the Rotary Club Scholarship Committee following personal interviews of those candidates who meet stated qualifications.

How to apply:

Applications are available from your Senior Guidance Counselor or Rotary Club Scholarship, 700 Westchester Park Drive, Springfield, Ohio 45504. The application, your essay, two recommendation forms and a transcript must be received at Rotary Club Scholarship, 700 Westchester Park Drive, Springfield, Ohio 45504, and **postmarked no later than March 20, 2020**.
