**KIWANIS FOUNDATION OF SPRINGFIELD, OHIO  
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES**

The Kiwanis Foundation of Springfield, Ohio will honor seniors graduating from Springfield and Clark County high schools by granting as many as seven, \$2,500, non-renewable scholarships. Once recipients are selected, the scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college or university attended by the recipient.

Scholarships will be presented at a Kiwanis meeting at 11:30 on Tuesday, May 19, 2020. Scholarship award winners are expected to attend the luncheon with up to three guests and make a brief (3 minutes maximum) speech about their favorite service project.

**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES**

1. The applicant must:
  - be in the top fifteen percent of his/her graduating class,
  - be accepted for enrollment at any four-year college or Clark State Community College for the following academic year.
2. The application must submit the following:
  - a completed Scholarship Application form, including list of service activities and description of employment;
  - an official transcript of grades and class rank as of the seventh semester;
  - a typed or handwritten statement of his/her plans for college and career, not to exceed one 8½" x 11" page; and
  - a letter of recommendation from someone who has personal knowledge of the applicant's participation in a service activity. This person may be a school official or someone outside of the school.
3. Criteria used for selection of scholarship recipients:
  - demonstrated academic ability and potential for academic work at the college level, and
  - service activities that benefit the applicant's school, fellow students, church, nonprofit organizations, or other members of the community.
4. The applicant may be called for an interview with the selection committee.

Once completed, please return to your Guidance Counselor, Academic Advisor or Scholarship Coordinator for your school.

Materials must be received by the Scholarship Committee or postmarked on or before Friday, April 10, 2020. PLEASE NOTE: to be fair to all applicants, this date will be firmly upheld as in previous years!
